

On the Nature of Certificates

All Certificates including oaths undertaken by Practitioners and Tutors of Interuniversalism Erfan Halgheh (IEH) share significant qualities, as defined below:

- The documents are designed as a code of ethics to define standards of conduct for the IEH community. They are translated sense-for-sense, as faithfully as possible, from the original documents as written in Farsi by founder Mohammad Ali Taheri.
- The documents define for Practitioners and Tutors the key functional elements of their respective Complementary Alternative Medicine (CAM) - Faradarmani or Psymtology - and the conditions under which the functionality of the related Halghehs ("Links") will cease to have an effect, or cause an adverse or unintended effect.
- Each Individual takes an oath upon their own integrity, and the integrity of the Interuniversal Consciousness Network, so as not to limit or hinder any other commitment or oath the individual might take or has taken.
- The documents serve primarily as a commitment that the Individual makes with themselves, and the Interuniversal Consciousness Network. They also serve as an assurance to any third party who is curious about, or wishes to receive a CAM. Each Individual retains the original document of their Certificate or Oath, while their Tutor retains a hard or digitized copy.
